Speaker: DENNIS J. COHEN

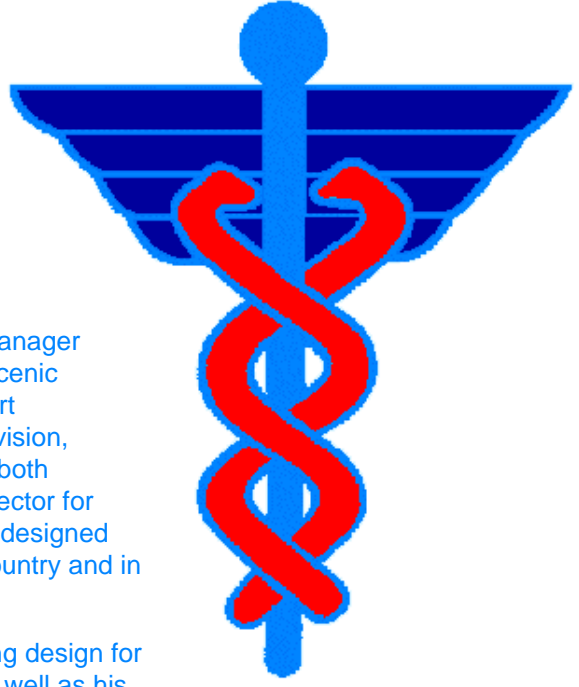
