As an educational side note: GE, Philips and Osram/Sylvania have been granted an extension on some of the 32WT8 lamps for a period of two years (2014). The lamps were originally to stop manufacturing in July of 2012. However, after the DOE energy conservation standards were issued, the severe export restrictions have occurred. The restrictions have caused huge cost increases and supply concerns for the rare earth materials required to produce the phosphors needed to meet the new efficiency standards. The older 32WT8 lamps consume less phosphor material than the newer energy efficient replacement lamps. Here's a link to GE's website explaining the issue. There are also similar letters from Philips and Osram/Sylvania on their websites as well. For more information, contact your local lamp representative.

Thanks again for a very good year. We have had between 33 and 55 people attending each of our educational programs this year and hope the attendance will grow next year. I have already received calls for potential programs for the 2012–2013 season.
