The program will have a short segment devoted to the related IES standards (*RP-5-13 Recommended Practice for Daylighting Buildings*, *IES LM-83-12 Approved Method: IES Spatial Daylight Autonomy (sDA) and Annual Sunlight Exposure (ASE)*, *LEM-7-13 Lighting Controls for Energy Management*, as well as *IES SEM-6-11 Daylighting*). The presenter will also have a brief overview of newly published IES standards, updated Seminars, and other distance learning opportunities, including the LC Study Group, SALC, and Annual Conference. The presentation will have brief summaries of ASHRAE 2010, Title 24, IECC, and LEED 2012, as they relate to both subject areas, as well as resources on local climate and meteorological data.

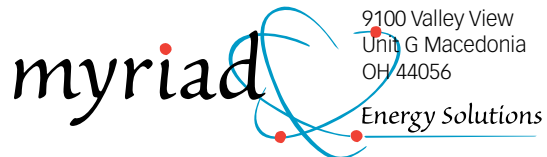
