## Future Applications of Lighting Control technologies

Modern lighting control communications networks are proving themselves to be the ideal communications infrastructure to support the transfer of a myriad of environmental sensor data types. This stream of environmental data is a financial windfall for municipalities and utilities struggling to maintain and modernize their aging lighting infrastructure. Mark Wilbur, of GE Lighting, will share what the industry is doing with networked lighting controls (NLCs) and plans for the near future including operational monitoring and control, time and use of metering, automatic fixture registration via machine to machine (M2M) communication with central management system, and gunshot and radiation detection.

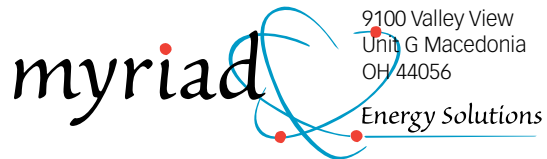
