Form Follows Function: How changing Library Practices are echoed in Design Choices

The changing dynamic of public library collections requires designers to rethink how we light library spaces. Today's public libraries are in the process of shifting their image and culture to accommodate the changing needs of their patrons. Libraries are community centers with meeting rooms; they offer children's activity centers and teen programs; Internet access to those without (with assistance on how-to); they are computing centers; are for all ages. A case study of a recently completed public library branch in Ohio emphasizes how the library's greater goals in meeting patron expectations, were echoed in the design choices. The case study covers luminaire selection as well as control strategy.

In addition, she contributes to the following national committees to maintain her expertise in the industry: IES Progress Report Committee, IES Library Lighting Committee, and the IALD Spec integrity Task Force. Ms. Zinkon regularly serves as a guest lecturer at the Ohio State University, Miami University, and Kent State. Her expertise within the lighting industry is regularly sought out; she has presented at Lightfair International five times over the past seven years. Additional national speaking engagements include: IALD Enlighten Americas Conference, IES Annual Conference, NeoCon, and NeoCon East and GovEnergy.

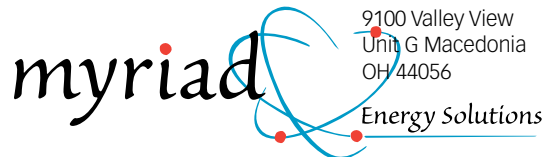
